

School Concert Program 21-22 General Policies and Procedures

21-22 Program Overview

Cost:

- \$10 student ticket- includes concert curriculum, 30-minute on campus musician visit (virtual or in person) and final 45-minute full orchestra performance at the Robinson Performing Arts Center in Plano
- Music and/or classroom teachers attend performance free of charge
- On campus musician visits and free teacher tickets are contingent on purchase of 40 \$10 student tickets. Musician visits may be purchased for \$120 for smaller groups.
- Musician visits are contingent on location within our service area

Registration

- Initial registration opens Sept. 8 and closes Nov. 1 via Google form
- Concert dates and times are assigned on a first come, first serve basis and will be confirmed by the end of September for early registrants
- Late registration will occur in January and seating for final concert cannot be guaranteed
- Schools with confirmation of participation will receive access to online virtual content in October
- Final numbers and special accommodations for participants in final concert will be due 30 days prior to concert. No changes to number of student participants will be allowed after this date.
- Invoices will be issued 21 days prior to concert and are due by date of concert

Final concert

- The final concerts will take place in the Robinson Performing Arts Center
- Concert seating charts and bus parking information will be emailed 10 days prior to concert

Musician Visits

- Musician visits will be scheduled for January-March and may be conducted on campus or on zoom
- Musician visit dates will be assigned prior to winter break
